EB COMMUNITY CARE

Our Family Support Team (FST):

Offers a bespoke model of service *from birth, diagnosis and beyond.*

Supports families living in both the North and the South of Ireland

Offer home visits to families

Offer support calls to families

Are available over 5 days per week

Make avg 50 calls / visits per month

We currently fund EB outreach nurse working out of Children's Health Ireland, (CHI) at Crumlin

We meet monthly and quarterly with the team in CHI, believing good communication results in better services for families

Agreed funding for 2nd EB Outreach Nurse between CHI and St James's (SJH)

Collaborating with CHI and SJH to scope out role

Oversee all service-level agreement (SLA) input for DEBRA Ireland

Create clear pathway of communication for post holder

Fund bespoke care packages for families

Provide Support to all stakeholders

Collaborate with Disability Federation Ireland (DFI) – setting up of national FST networking group

Offer and fund Supervision to EB nurses working with families in the community



2 x Family Support Team = 1.4 FTE

1 x Head Office = 0.1 FTE



FINANCE & SUPPORT

Oversee all funding and grant expenditure within the service.

We are patient led and respond to our families emerging needs

We have a number of different income streams available to families

Process AVG €60K-€70k per annum directly to families for their wellbeing
